Our Tech Stack

Our platform: On the front-end, Our new portal UI, in which you will be heavily focusing on, is built with Angular 6, ngrx, RxJS, D3.js, SCSS.

On the back-end, it's Java-based application (Java 8), with Spring Framework (Spring 5) and Spring Boot-based microservices (Spring Boot 2) with Docker. We use PostgreSQL as our database. The legacy UI is built with JSP, ¡Query, and AngularJS.

We are using AWS as our hosting infrastructure. The platform can be built, tested, and deployed with a single click through Jenkins. We leverage Selenium for our UI Automation testing.
